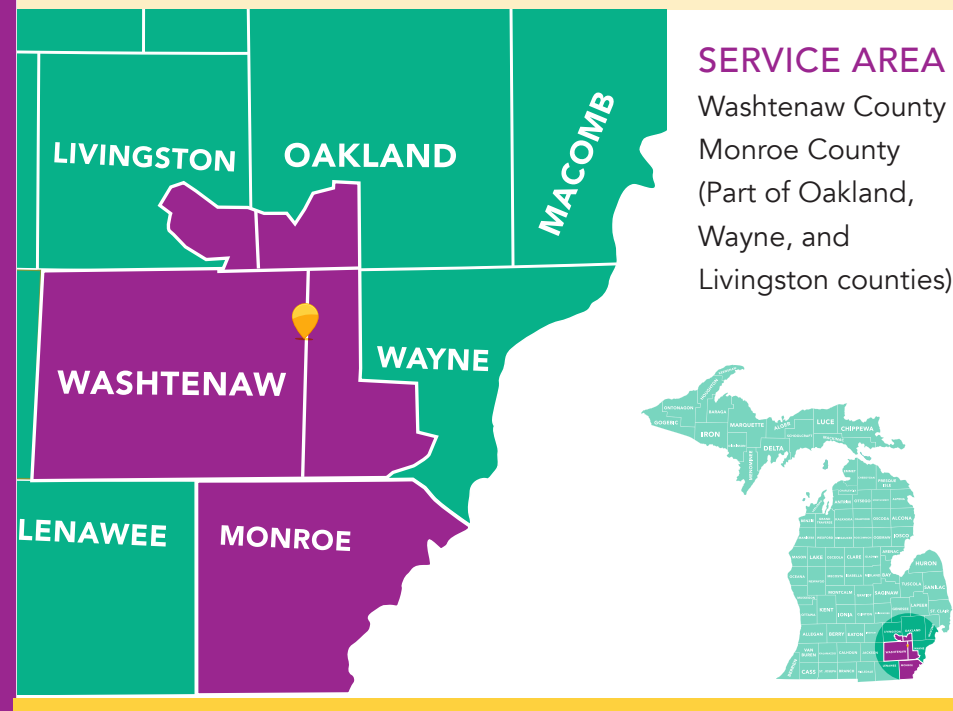
“Before PACE I was alone at home and not socializing with other people. I was not getting out of my house and was very sad and lonely. I really was ‘on my own’ and didn’t have any friends or support. It was a very hard time for me.”

“People listen to me at PACE and pay attention to me and there is no better feeling than that. I made a speech about a month ago, and you could have dropped a pin on the ground and heard it, everyone was so quiet and patient with me. They listened to what I had to say.”

“PACE makes me feel a part of the world and involved in the community. People are friendly and welcoming and I feel like I have a purpose here. Like I belong. People take the time to show me how to do things if I need help or explain things to me I don’t know or understand.”

WHAT IS PACE®?

Who Pays for PACE?

What you *pay for PACE depends on your financial* situation. Participants enrolled in both Medicare and Medicaid or just Medicaid alone, have no co-payments or deductibles. You may be fully liable for the costs of medical services from an out-of-network provider or without prior authorization (with the exception of emergency services). Our enrollment team can help assist with new Medicaid applications. With Medicare alone, there is a cost-sharing option.

PACE gives my son and daughter a break.

When Pat used to drive, she had a routine and could come and go as she pleased. Now that she has more health concerns, she doesn’t socialize like she once did. She watched TV and played games on her tablet. Even though she has a big family near by, she still felt isolated.

THERAPY SERVICES

The Huron Valley PACE provides skilled physical, occupational and speech therapy as needed. Therapy services can help increase independence and safety. Our staff offers real life therapy options to help keep our participants independent at home.

TRANSPORTATION

Huron Valley PACE offers door-through-door transportation to medical appointments and our Day Center. We partner with Huron Valley Ambulance to arrange all transportation needs.



With oversight from our Geriatric Physician, primary and urgent care is provided in the PACE medical center. Our geriatric nurse practitioners, nurse and clinical staff help coordinate care.

SERVICE DELIVERY

Huron Valley PACE provides medical and supportive services in our Day Center. We also provide transportation to and from the Day Center. We offer a variety of services that can be provided in the comfort of your own home. We have relationships with many specialists and providers in the community who ensure that participants receive the care they need. Services provided can include:

- Primary and Specialty Care
- Prevention Services & Education
- Nursing Care
- Social Work & Case Management
- Medications and Medication Management
- Nutrition Counseling & Meals. (Breakfast and lunch are offered at the day center. We also offer frozen meals to take home)
- Activities, Social Opportunities, and Outings
- Optometry & Dental Care
- Home Health & Personal Care
- Caregiver Respite
- Hospital & Long-Term Care
- Medical Equipment
- Physical, Occupational & Speech Therapy
- All Medicare & Medicaid covered services
- Medical Transportation
- Other Services as Necessary

ELIGIBILITY

To join Huron Valley PACE an individual must:

- Be age 55 or older
- Be certified as meeting the State of Michigan criteria for nursing facility level-of-care
- Live within the Huron Valley PACE service area (including Washtenaw and Monroe counties, as well as part of Oakland, Wayne, and Livingston counties)
- Be able to live safely in the community with the support of Huron Valley PACE

Nursing home level of care means someone who is struggling physically or with their memory. We evaluate with a simple phone call followed by an eligibility assessment provided by our PACE intake team.
